CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

The purpose of this study was to determine the pragmatics phenomenom in *Meme Comics*. The study is related to the conversation and picture in the comic. Next, there are two problems which are discussed in this study. The first is to find out the kinds of speech acts. Then, the second is to explain the function of the speech acts.

Furthermore, the problems which are formulated are answer, the first problem here identified the *Meme Comics* into several kinds of speech acts. Those are representatives, directives, commissives, expressives, and declaratives. The representatives are found in 14 comics whereas the directives are found in 10 comics. Next, there are 5 comics which are classified into commissives. Then, 19 comics are classified into expressives and 8 comics are classified into declarations.

The second problem reveals the function of speech acts in detail. There are some functions in speech acts such as the functions of representatives are to assert (12) and to conclude (2). Then, the functions of directives are to order (9) and to request (1). Next, the functions of commissives are to promise (2) and to offer (3). Meanwhile, the functions of expressives are to express anger (6), shock (4), disappointment (2), suspicion (1), amazement (1), and insinuation (5), whereas the functions of the declaratives are to confirm (1) and to declare (7).

There are a lot of interesting subjects to discuss within the *Meme Comics*. The comics have a meaningful message behind the conversation. Therefore, there are many topics of pragmatics that could be drawn from *Meme Comics*. This research is one of the pragmatic problems which analyzes the comic based on the theory of speech acts. The pragmatics itself has a lot of theories to solve some problems; such as implicature or violation of maxim in *Meme Comics*. In conclusion, *Meme Comics* have some pragmatics phenomenon which are undiscovered yet and it can be made as a further research.
