

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION

In this chapter the researcher concludes all the problem of the research entitled **“The Portrait of Depression Seen through Metaphor in Wilfred Owen’s “Disabled”**. The main source of data which is analyzed in this research is a poem. Besides that the main discussion is about the portrait of depression seen through metaphor in a poem “Disabled”. It is about the speaker’s depression that happens in his life between the past and future. The depression is a mental disorder which has been faced by someone caused by many factors. There is two aims of the research to help understanding the discussion. They are explaining metaphor dealing with depression seen through in Disabled and explaining the symbol dealing with depression in a poem Disabled.

There are two problems to be solved by the researcher. They are the metaphor dealing with depression and symbol dealing with depression. To solve the problem the researcher uses some theories. The second is dealing with death. The symbol of death in this analysis is about the speaker's soul. There is no dream, ambition, anger and he cannot feel anything anymore. The speaker gives up his condition and he is wasting for his death
