ABSTRACT

The research entitled *An Analysis of Appositive Noun Phrase in English* discusses the kinds and the structures of appositive noun phrase in English.

The researcher applies content analysis to conduct this research. This method uses some steps; they are collecting the data, classifying the data, and analyzing the data. The source of the data was *Campus* magazine published by Pelita Harapan University. The population of this research is appositive noun phrases used in sentences. The technique applied to take the sample was the purposive sampling.

Furthermore, the analysis applied expansion technique to describe the kinds and the structures of appositive noun phrases. Based on the kinds of appositive noun phrases, the researcher finds 63 sentences. Non-restrictive appositive is the most productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine. While, the less productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine is list appositive with pronoun.

Meanwhile, in the analysis based on the structures of appositive noun phrases, the researcher also finds 63 sentences. The most productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine is Subject + Appositive Noun Phrase. Whereas, Appositive Noun Phrase + Subject is the less productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian yang berjudul *An Analysis of Appositive Noun Phrase in English* ini membahas tentang jenis-jenis dan struktur-struktur *appositive noun phrase* dalam Bahasa Inggris.

Peneliti menerapkan metode analisis konten untuk menjalankan penelitian ini. Penelitian ini menggunakan beberapa langkah, diantaranya mengumpulkan data, mengklasifikasi data, dan menganalisis data. Data penelitian ini diambil dari majalah *Campus* yang diterbitkan oleh Universitas Pelita Harapan. Populasi penelitian ini merupakan seluruh *appositive noun phrase* yang terdapat dalam kalimat. Sample diambil dengan menerapkan teknik *sample purposive*.

Selanjutnya, metode analisis yang digunakan untuk menggambarkan jenisjenis dan struktur appositive noun phrase adalah teknik penjabaran. Berdasarkan jenis-jenis appositive noun phrase, peneliti menemukan 63 kalimat. Nonrestrictive appositive adalah jenis appositive noun phrase yang paling banyak ditemukan di majalah Campus. Sedangkan, jenis appositive noun phrase yang paling sedikit muncul d majalah Campus adalah list appositive with pronoun.

Sementara itu, analisis berdasarkan struktur-struktur *appositive noun phrase*, peneliti juga menemukan 63 kalimat. Struktur *appositive noun phrase* yang paling banyak ditemukan d majalah *Campus* adalah Subjek + *Appositive Noun Phrase*. Sedangkan, *Appositive Noun Phrase* + Subjek adalah struktur yang paling sedikit ditemukan di majalah *Campus*.

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
