CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

This research entitled An Analysis of Appositive Noun Phrase in English focuses on the kinds and the structures of appositive noun phrases. Concerning its kinds, appositive noun phrase consists of non-restrictive appositive, restrictive appositive, appositive that repeats a noun, negative appositive, multiple appositive, and list appositives pronoun. Due to its structure, an appositive noun phrase can be placed after or before the noun that it follows.

This research applied content analysis to analyze the data of appositive noun phrase. The total number of the data to analyze is 63 appositive noun phrases in 63 sentences. Here, the data were taken from the *Campus* magazine published by Pelita Harapan University. The technique applied to take the sample was the purposive sampling.

The analysis applied expansion technique to describe the kinds and the structures of appositive noun phrases. The result of the data analyzed in this research is 63 sentences. Related to its kinds, non-restrictive appositive is the most productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine. While, the less productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine is list appositive with pronoun.

Meanwhile, in the analysis based on the structures, the most productive appositive noun phrase is Subject + Appositive Noun Phrase. Whereas,

Appositive Noun Phrase + Subject is the less productive appositive noun phrase found in *Campus* magazine.

Based on the analysis of appositive noun phrases, their kinds and their structures will be more easily understood if we comprehend the relationship of each elements and the meaning in the sentence.

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
