CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

The researcher draws a conclusion that the problems are discussed and analyzed in this chapter. The researcher chooses poetry to be analyzed. Poetry is an imaginative awareness of experience expressed through meaning, sound and rhythmic language choices so as to evoke an emotional response. The researcher's analysis is entitled *Imagery and Symbol Portraying the Loneliness in William Wordsworth's I Wandered Lonely as a cloud*.

Wordsworth applies some words that show imageries and symbols in his poem. The researcher analyzes all imageries and symbols portraying the loneliness found in *I Wandered Lonely as a cloud*. The poet figures out a picture of the men are lonely from the society. The researcher finds some problems that occur and are interesting to be analyzed. The problems are the imageries and symbols portraying the loneliness in *I Wandered Lonely as a cloud*.

These problems are analyzed using four theories. They are the theory of imagery, symbol, psychology and psychological disorder. The first theory is imagery. Imagery is the use of words to appeal to one of the five senses: sight, sound, touch, hearing and taste. There are seven kinds of imageries. They are visual imagery, auditory imagery, olfactory imagery, gustatory imagery, tactile imagery, kinesthetic imagery and organic imagery. The second theory is symbol. Symbol is something that is used not only literally but also as a way to represent something else. The third theory is psychology. Psychology is the scientific study

of the mind and behavior. The fourth theory is psychological disorder. Psychological disorder is used to determine to what are frequently known as mental disorder.

There are two approaches used to used to analyses the data. They are structural and psychological approaches. Structural approach is used to analyze word constituent. The second approach is psychological approach is used to identify loneliness that happen in Wordsworth's poem.

They are visual imagery, organic imagery, kinesthetic imagery. Visual imagery is applied in *I Wandered Lonely as a* cloud line 3 and 4, *When all at once I saw a crowd, A host, of golden daffodils.* The speaker feels uncomfortable to join some people. In the speaker's mind, people in the world have many conflicts like fighting each other, gossiping, making affair, envying with other people and et cetera. He tries to join nature in order to find comfort and happiness. In the middle of his journey, he finds the group of daffodils. The beauty of daffodil can impress all people who look at it, until the speaker also admires it. He comes to daffodils closely to identify. The speaker realizes that the beauty of daffodil only can be seen from far away. In fact when speaker comes closely, daffodil is not beauty as what does his mind. Daffodil refers to a girl who is always good and never does anything bad and he knows deeply about the girl.

Organic imagery emerges in *I Wandered Lonely as a cloud line* 1, *I wandered lonely as a cloud*. The speaker describes how he walked around and felt as lonely as a cloud. It means roaming around without a purpose. He feels

purposeless and directionless. The cloud could be lonely because it is so far above the rest of the world. It is like the speaker's feeling his life is so full of loneliness. The speaker makes a distance to society. He gets difficulty to make a friend. According people, speaker is strange person because his habit, attitude and how to think are different with other but speaker thinks otherwise, the society is peculiar. They do not even understand at all about his idea.

Kinesthetic imagery that occur in *I Wandered Lonely as a cloud* is line 6, *Fluttering and dancing in the breeze*. The reader can imagine a soft of breeze causes the daffodils to flutter and to dance. A bird and a butterfly perch some daffodils. It makes daffodil swings to left right like as dancing. The movement of daffodil is like flutter to the sky. The dancing of daffodil can describe everybody will love it at the first sight. Fluttering and dancing of daffodil has appeal to attract attention at all creature that see it. They can be admiring at daffodil. A flutter of daffodil can be felt when the speaker feels sad, alone and worried. In the speaker's mind, daffodil can give him happiness to forget his entire problem. He loses his loneliness.

The researcher also represents the symbols portraying the loneliness that happen. They are symbol of alienation, symbol of deserted and symbol of depressed. Symbol of alienation can be seen in *I Wandered Lonely as a cloud* is line 1, *I Wandered Lonely as a cloud*, Cloud is very high from the land, The speaker's consideration is different from others. Basically cloud makes a group. It is like a normal human being, they live together and need each other. They help, exchange thought and greet each other.

The speaker feels like a cloud separated from the world below. The life of the speaker is isolated from the society. Although the speaker can see all the people do, but he cannot join their activities. Nobody wants to accompany him, he does not have a friend to share his problem. No one can understand about his mind and wants. The society also does not care about his life.

Actually, the speaker has many beautiful dreams. He thinks that his dream can give many benefits for many people. His idea comes directly, it is like a cloud which comes in the nice weather. However people do not think like this. People think, he has peculiar thought. His idea is often foolish for other people. The speaker's idea can be applied only for himself, without considering the other people can do it or not. Therefore, the society give label "alienated" to the speaker.

Speaker expresses a more permanent kind of happiness. He has many questions in his mind. He confuses why up to now his life still has many problems. He also asking how should his life in the future and how to solve his problems. Actually all of his problems because of him or the society. In his life, the speaker gets many events that make him stress. The event is very sadness. The sadness bothers his feeling. He is worried. The worried makes him depression. He always asks

why he feels like this. Many people feel happy when getting nice atmosphere. The speaker does not feel like them. Nice atmosphere cannot change his mood.
