Structural approach is used to analyze the poem from the structure of the words. They are analyzed word by word to find the meaning that revealing the theme. Deeply, it also analyzes the meaning of the words especially the symbols. Historical Biographical Approach assumes that the text is a reflection of the author's life and times. This approach is used to understand the context in which the author lived in order to fully interpret and evaluate the text.
