CONCLUSION

After establishing, collecting, and analyzing the data, the researcher draws a conclusion. The announcers of FM radio stations in Madiun use code-switching in their daily programs. They usually use conversational code-switching. They never use metaphorical code switching and situational code switching. It is in line with the fact that the researcher finds no alteration in topic or situation. The announcers use code switching in the same topic and situation. Consequently, it is not condition of metaphorical code switching or of situational code switching.

The announcers usually mix two languages, Bahasa Indonesia and English. The reasons of the announcers to use English items in their speech of Bahasa Indonesia are they think that English is an international language to go up to global culture. Next, the announcers want to spread out English in this society. They also want to bring English close to the listeners. They want to clear up the messages to the listeners, they think that it is an education, it is a style and variation of announcers, it is a skill, it is more relax it is not show off but it is natural, it is to suit the trend, it is a training for listeners to be fluent in speaking English, it is a habit, etcetera.

Finally, the researcher concludes that there are three linguistic forms used by the announcers of FM radio stations in Madiun in the process of code-switching namely words, phrases and sentences.

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
