ABSTRACT

The objectives of the research entitled *The Main Character's Love and Unfair Treatments that Influence Her Progress in Charlotte Bronte's Jane Eyre* are (1) to describe love experiences undergone by Jane Eyre, the main character of *Jane Eyre*. (2) to describe the unfair treatments undertaken by Jane Eyre (3) to analyze Jane Eyre's progress due to her love and the unfair treatments. Library research including internet browsing is employed to find the relevant theories. The data corpus of this research are all of the phrases, clauses, sentences and even paragraphs and discourses related to the main character's love and her progress in Charlotte Bronte's *Jane Eyre*. Psychological and social approaches are used to analyze the data.

Firstly, Jane Eyre as the main character experiences two kinds of love, neighbor's love and romantic love. The neighbor's love she gets from her maid, her friend and teacher at Lowood School, Mrs. Fairfax and Adele. Jane's romantic love is with Mr. Rochester, her master when she becomes a governess at Thornfield. Secondly, Jane Eyre gets some unfair treatments in her childhood and in her adulthood. In her childhood she gets unfair treatments from her aunt, cousins and maid. At Lowood School she also gets unfair treatments from her teacher. In her adulthood she gets the unfair treatments from her aunt and her new neighbor at Thornfield. Thirdly, due to love and the unfair treatments undertaken by Jane Eyre, Jane has some progress. They are emotional progress, materialistic progress and career progress.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian yang berjudul *The Main Character's Love that Influences Her Progress in Charlotte Bronte's Jane Eyre* bertujuan untuk (1) mendeskripsikan pengalaman cinta yang dimiliki oleh Jane Eyre. (2) mendeskripsikan perlakuan tidak adil yang dialami oleh Jane Eyre (3) menganalisa kemajuan yang dialami Jane Eyre berdasarkan cinta dan perlakuan tidak adil yang dialaminya. Studi kepustakaan termasuk mengakses internet digunakan untuk mendapatkan teori yang sesuai. Data yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah semua frasa, Klaus, kalimat dan bahkan paragraph dan wacana yang berkaitan dengan cinta dan kemajuan yang dialami oleh tokoh utama dalam novel karya Charlotte Bronte yang berjudul *Jane Eyre*. Untuk menganalisa data digunakan pendekatan psikologi dan social.

Pertama, Jane Eyre sebagai tokoh utama mempunyai dua pengalaman cinta, cinta dari lingkungan sekitarnya dan cinta romantic.cinta dari orang – orang sekitarnya dia dapat dari pembantunya, temannya dan gurunya di Sekolah Lowood, Bu Fairfax dan Adele. Cinta romantisnya dia dapat dari Tuan Rochester, majikannya saat dia menjadi guru privat di Thornfield. Yang kedua, Jane Eyre mengalami beberapa perlakuan yang tidak adil saat masa kecilnya dan juga ketika dia dewasa. Saat masa kecilnya dia mendapat perlakuan tidak adil dari bibinya, sepupunya dan pembantunya. Di sekolah Lowood dia juag mrndapatkan perlakuan tidak adil dari gurunya. Saat dia dewasa dia mendapatkan perlakuan tidak adil dari bibinya dan lingkungan barunya di Thornfield. Ketiga, berdasarkan cinta dan perlakuan tidak adil yang dia alami, Jane mengalami beberapa kemajuan, antara lain: kemajuan emotional, materi dan karir.

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
