

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

The research entitled *A Study on Word Coinage in MotoGP World Championship* has a purpose to solve the problems, they are, to describe the kinds of word coinage which happens in MotoGP World Championship and to describe the process of the formation of the term in MotoGP World Championship. The source of data of this analysis is taken from <http://www.motogp.com/en/About+MotoGP>.

The kinds of word coinage which happens in MotoGP are acronymy, compounding (endocentric compound and exocentric compound), clipping, derivation, and antonomasia. The total number of data finds in this analysis is 48 data. The data analysis showed that word coinage formed through *acronymy* are 4 (10,4%) in number, word coinage through compounding are 29 (58,4%) in number. It is derived from 21 (41,7%) data of endocentric compound and 8 (16,7%) data of exocentric compound, word coinage through clipping are 5 (10,4%) in number, word coinage through derivation are 6 (12,5%) in number, and word coinage through antonomasia are 4 (8,3%) in number.

Next, the researcher discussed the process of the formation of word coinage in MotoGP World Championship. The analysis shows most of the acronyms are formed from the initials letters of the word. In this analysis, two types of compound is found, such as, endocentric compound and exocentric compound. An endocentric compound is formed from compound noun+noun,

compound adjective+noun, compound noun+adjective, compound verb+noun. Then, exocentric compound is formed from compound noun+noun and compound adjective+noun. In addition, clipping has four types, such as, back clipping, middle clipping, fore clipping, and complex clipping. However, only back clipping which finds in this analysis. Moreover, there is a derivational affix which is applied to the word of one syntactic category and changes them into another syntactic category. In this analysis, for example, suffix -ship and suffix -ion, both of this suffix functioning to form noun. But not all of derivational affix changes the syntactic category sometimes it can change the meaning, for example, the prefix dis- that has negative meaning. The others word coinage that is found in this analysis is word from names. Sometimes is taken from the name of the people. Besides that, the researcher also finds the name of the company that becomes the name of their product.

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
