

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION

The research entitled *An Analysis of Adjective Word Order in English* has a purpose to solve the problems of the researcher, namely, the kinds of adjective and the order of adjectives in English. The researcher takes the source of this analysis from a novel entitled *Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone* by J.K Rowling which is published in 2004.

The kinds of adjectives in English are the adjective of determiner (article/number, demonstrative, possessive), descriptive (proper, participle, compound), size, opinion, age, shape, color, and origin. The researcher finds 90 data of the kind of adjective in English. They are 19 data of adjective of determiner (number/article, possessive, demonstrative), 10 data of quality of character (opinion), 14 data of adjective of size, 4 data of adjective of age, 3 data of adjective of shape, 7 data of demonstrative (proper adjective), 12 data of demonstrative (participial adjective), 7 data of demonstrative (compound adjective), 8 data of adjective of color, and 2 data of adjectives of origin.

Next, the researcher discusses the order of adjectives in English. The analysis shows the order of two adjectives, the order of three adjectives and the order of four adjectives. The researcher finds 35 data of the order of adjectives. There are 11 data shows the order of two adjectives (determiner—size—head noun), 21 data of the order of three adjectives (size—opinion—color—head noun), and 3 data of the order of four adjectives (cardinal number—opinion—past participial adjective—color—noun).
