

## CHAPTER IV

### CONCLUSION

After analyzing the whole problems, the writer comes to the following conclusion. The objective of this study, entitled the Comparative Study on the Concept of Animalism in George Orwell's *Animal Farm* and that of Communism are (1) to describe the similarities between concept of Animalism in George Orwell's *Animal Farm* and that of communism, and (2) to describe the differences between concept of Animalism in George Orwell's *Animal Farm* and that of Communism. Further, the writer uses library research and Internet browsing to form the conceptual data and use them to find the relevant data in this novel. The data corpus of this thesis includes all of the phrases, clauses, sentences, and event, discourses that have relation with concept of Animalism and that of Communism found in George Orwell's *Animal Farm*. They can be in form of dialogues or narratives. Moreover, sociological approach is taken to analyze the data. Sociological approach focuses on the factor that influences communism and concept of Animalism possibilities.

There are similarities between concept of animalism in George Orwell's *Animal Farm* and that of communism. They are in the background, governmental system, belief and ideal life. Both concept of animalism in (*Animal Farm*), and communism in (*Soviet Union*) appeared because they want to be free the capital owner (employee)' oppression, which make them live in misery. They want such condition in which everything is available easily, there are no oppression from the

higher class (they should in the same level, right, obligatory) and especially there are no class dividing in society.

There are also differences between concept of animalism and that of communism. The first difference is in the individual leadership. Napoleon (leader in *Animal Farm*) only cares for the right and welfare of himself and his group, he does not have respect to the right of the animals in the farm. While, Stalin (leader in *Soviet Union*) just hopes to the real of communist society, he does not want to made himself rich and get anything, he also cares for the people right. The second difference is in social-economic. In the true concept of animalism, the animals forbid to have any dealing with humans, never to trades and never to use money. While, in Communist Society (*Soviet Union*) tends to dominate trade and economy.

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
