

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

This research entitled *An Analysis of Suffix -ly and its derivatives in English*, aims to solve the problems of the study, namely: what are the structures of words attached by suffix *-ly* and its derivatives, and what are the categories of words attached by suffix *-ly* and its derivatives. The objectives of the study are to describe the structure of words which are attached by suffix *-ly* and to determine the categories of words attached by suffix *-ly*. Suffix *-ly* can be attached to the parts of speech and the results are adjective and adverb.

In this research the total number of suffix *-ly* as the data are 100. The analysis of suffix *-ly* is resulting 12 of words ending in *-ly* as adjective and 88 of words ending in *-ly* as adverb. Adjective ending in *-ly* is classified into two structures, they are: noun + *-ly* as in *friend-friendly* and the structure of adjective + *-ly* as in *live-lively*. Furthermore, adverb ending in *-ly* has five structures, they are: the structure of noun + *-ly* as in *day-daily*, the structure of simple adjective + *-ly* as in *quick -quickly*, the structure of derived adjective + *-ly* as in *hopeful-hopefully*, the structure of *-ing* adjective + *-ly* as in *surprising-surprisingly*, and the structure of *-ed* adjective + *-ly* as in *allege -allegedly*.

Suffix *-ly* and its derivatives can be categorized as adjective and adverb. Adjective ending in *-ly* have some categories they are: adjective ending in *-ly* function as attributive, predicative and the head of noun phrase. Besides adverb

ending in *-ly*, has some categories they are: adverb ending in *-ly* as adverb of affirmation, adverb of degree, adverb of manner, adverb of time, adverb of doubt, and gradable adverb.

It can be concluded that not all of the words ending in *-ly* are categorized as adverb, but few adjectives are also ending in *-ly*. The high proportion of adverb is formed from adjective.

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
