## **CHAPTER V**

## CONCLUSION

The meaning and the use of the automotive register of the Volvo 960 owner's manual book divided into nine sections as follows:

- 1. Instrument and controls: gauge, warning lamps, direction indicators, headlamp flasher, main beam, dipped beam, hazard warning lamps, fog lamps, tailgate window wiper, tailgate, sun roof, and sun visor.
- 2. Body and interior: central locking door, lock knob, lumbar support, ignition key, number tag, courtesy lighting, interior light, warning lights, storage compartment, bonnet, boot hatch, and SRS airbags,
- 3. Starting and driving: catalytic converter, fuel cap, fuel's vapor pressure, manual gearbox, automatic gearbox, reverse gears lock, reverse gear inhibitor, reverse gear catch, throttle pedal, preheating (glow) indicator lamp, Front towing eyelet and rear towing eyelet, roof rack refers, roof racks, ABS brake system,
- 4. Wheel and tires: tread wear indicators, flat spots, snow tires and snow chains, tire pressure,
- 5. In case of emergency: misfiring, ignite, faulty ignition system, spark plug, distributor cap, ignition system, radiator, coolant, and fan belt, fuse, relays, dashboard, alloy rims, steel rim, wheel nuts,

wheel hub, small guide stud brake disc; wheel bolts, torque, hub cap, the jack, headlamp bulbs, fog lights, main beam, auxiliary light, parking light, reversing light, turn signals, brake light, tail light, boot light, cargo space light, courtesy light, reading lights, high-level brake lights, socket, wattage, bulb holder, housing, guide lugs and tail light cluster.

- 6. Car care: rust-proofing, rust formation, underbody and wheel-arches rust-proofing compound, rust-proofing agent, and moisture ingress.
- 7. Service and routine maintenance: engine compartment, gearbox oil, engine oil, power assisted steering, brake fluid, lubrication, body, coolant, drive belts, washer reservoir, wipers, and diesel fuel system, 4-cylinder engine compartment, coolant system, oil filter cap, dipstick engine, dipstick automatic transmission, brake fluid reservoir, power steering pump, data plate, battery, air filter, water pump belts, alternator belt, air conditioning belt, thermoelectric cooling fan, washer nozzles, washer reservoir, windscreen washer reservoir, wiper blades and wiper blades.
- 8. Specifications: chassis type, wheelbase and maximum axle, lubricant single dry clutch, fully synchronized 5-speed gearbox, fully automatic 4-speed gearbox, hydraulic converter, and planetary gear. The specification of front end electrical system reveals some register likes voltage regulated alternator, single pole

system, electrolysis, specific gravity, starter motor and engine, voltage regulated alternator, single-pole system, electrolysis, specific gravity, starter motor, output hp/rpm, torque, cylinders, bore, stroke, compression ratio, ignition setting, spark plug, electrode gap, and octane rating.

9. Emission control: *catalytic converter, lambda-sond system,*positive crankcase ventilation, and fuel evaporation system.

Register is a reflection of the context situation in which language is used, and the ways in which one type of situation is differ from one another. In other words, it can be said that register refers to the fact that the language we speak varies according to the type of situation.
