CONCLUSION

The objectives of the study are to describe the kinds and the purpose of Person deixis that occurs in "Victorian Ghost Stories by Mike stocks" in this stories have three story which the writer analyze: The Open Door, A Long Distance Call, and The Shadow of a Ghost. It is a stories written by Mike Stocks in 1996 and was published by us borne Publishing Ltd, England. The Person deixis will be discussed pragmatically. It done by reading some studies that are related to the person deixis, finding the person deixis in the stories, collecting, classifying, and tabulating the data. The data are analyzed descriptively.

The result of the research reveals three kinds of Person deixis that are used in "Victorian Ghost Stories by Mike Stocks". Based on analyzing 50 data of person deixis, there are 10 data (20%) categorized as the Person deixis Based on Social Status. The Person deixis Based on Rank is 3 data (6 %). The Person deixis Based on Occupation / Identity set is 6 data (12%)

The writer uses speech acts theory to know the purposes of the use of person deixis. They are Representative, directives, commissive, expressive and Declarative. Based on data the writer only analyze Expressive and Declarative. There are 6 data which are included into Expressive speech acts consist of 6 data (3%) and 5 data which are Declarative consist 5 data (25%). It means that Expressive and Declarative speech acts is the most dominant found in the "Victorian Ghost Stories by Mike Stocks"
