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## ABSTRACTS

The purpose of the thesis entitled "The Influence of Emotion on Marianne's Love and Suffering in Jane Austen's *Sense and Sensibility*" is to elaborate (1) Marianne's emotion, (2) Marianne's love, (3) Marianne's suffering, and (4) the influence of Marianne's emotion on her love and suffering.

The writer does library research to find the theory of influence, emotion, love, and suffering. Those theories are used to find the data. They can be words, phrases, clauses, or further discourse. Then, the data are analyzed descriptively based on sociological approach. The result of the study is only applied to the subject of analysis.

Marianne Dashwood is an emotional girl. She often behaves as what she pleases. She does not care that her manner will hurt other people. Marianne also experiences the romantic love, a strong emotional arousal and attraction toward another person, together with a need for the physical presence and support of the other person, caring, and intimate sharing. Her whole heart is devoted to her beloved one, that is, Willoughby. She feels that he is the most valuable thing in the world. No one may replace his position in her heart, not except Colonel Brandon, a man who sincerely loves Marianne. For that reason, she avoids to talk to Colonel Brandon after knowing that he loves her. She thinks that the Colonel is not proper to be in love because he is too old. Her sensibility makes her ignore the Colonel's kindness. Her parting from Willoughby makes Marianne always cry in her longing. Her memories together with Willoughby place her in such a dramatic depression. She plays over every favorite song that she has been used to play to Willoughby. It makes her feeling more devastating. Even, she is awake the whole night then, she gets ill. Willoughby, a man who has been placed more upon her feeling towards her own family, betrays her and marries to another woman. Meanwhile, the people she often insulted such as Mrs. Jennings, Lady Middleton, and Colonel Brandon support her when she gets suffering. Knowing the falsehood of her own opinions, Marianne wants to go away to avoid them because of her shyness. She also does not know how to answer all their questions.

## ABSTRAKSI

Tujuan tulisan yang berjudul “Pengaruh Emosi terhadap Cinta dan Penderitaan Marianne” dari novel karya Jane Austen yang berjudul *Sense and Sensibility* ini adalah menguraikan (1) emosi Marianne, (2) cinta Marianne, (3) penderitaan Marianne, dan (4) pengaruh emosi Marianne terhadap cinta dan penderitaannya.

Riset pustaka dilakukan untuk mencari teori tentang pengaruh, emosi, cinta, dan penderitaan. Teori-teori tersebut lalu digunakan untuk mencari data. Data tersebut dapat berupa kata, frase, klausa, ataupun wacana. Kemudian data tersebut dianalisa dengan menggunakan metode deskriptif dan pendekatan sosiologi pada subjek yang dianalisis.

Marianne Dashwood adalah seorang gadis yang emosional. Ia sering bertindak sesuka hatinya. Ia tidak peduli kalau sikapnya itu akan melukai orang lain. Marianne juga merasakan cinta yang romantis, suatu getaran emosi yang kuat dan ketertarikan terhadap orang lain, yang dibarengi dengan kebutuhan akan kehadiran secara fisik dan dukungan dari orang lain, perhatian, dan tukar pendapat secara mendalam. Hatinya dicurahkan sepenuhnya kepada kekasihnya yaitu Willoughby. Ia merasa bahwa Willoughby adalah sesuatu yang paling berharga di dunia. Tak seorangpun yang boleh menggantikan posisi Willoughby di hati Marianne, tidak terkecuali Colonel Brandon, pria yang mencintai Marianne dengan tulus. Karena itulah, ia menghindar dari Colonel Brandon setelah tahu kalau Colonel Brandon mencintainya. Menurutnya Colonel Brandon tidak pantas jatuh cinta karena sudah terlalu tua. Ketidakrasionalan itu membuatnya mengabaikan kebaikan Colonel Brandon. Perpisahannya dengan Willoughby membuat Marianne selalu menangis dalam kerinduan. Kenangannya bersama Willoughby menempatkannya pada sebuah depresi yang dramatis. Ia memainkan setiap lagu kesayangan yang biasanya ia mainkan untuk Willoughby. Hal itu membuat perasaannya semakin hancur. Bahkan, ia terjaga sepanjang malam, kemudian ia menjadi sakit. Willoughby, seorang pria yang telah mendapatkan tempat yang lebih di hatinya dibandingkan keluarga Marianne sendiri, kini mengkhianatinya dan menikahi wanita lain. Sementara itu, orang yang selalu Marianne hina seperti Nyonya Jennings, Lady Middleton, dan Colonel Brandon justru malah mendukungnya saat ia menderita. Mengetahui kekeliruan atas pendapatnya tersebut, Marianne ingin pergi menghindar dari mereka karena rasa malunya. Ia juga tidak tahu bagaimana harus menjawab semua pertanyaan mereka.
