ABSTRACT

ABSTRAK

Sastra adalah sebuah pokok permasalahan yang menciptakan harapan-harapan tertentu bagi para pembacanya. Hal itu menciptakan harapan-harapan tertentu karena sastra adalah sebuah produk yang kompleks dari imaginasi para sastrawan/sastrawati. Sastra dibagi menjadi tiga, yaitu: puisi, drama, dan prosa. Dalam thesis ini, penulis menganalisa tentang puisi. Puisi adalah sebuah karya sastra dalam bentuk tertulis; biasanya, bahasa yang dipakai dalam puisi adalah bahasa yang mempunyai irama.
