CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

Language is a tool of communication when someone interact with other.

The interaction is happen between someone with other such as male with male, female with female and cross enversation that is female with male.

Based on the interaction, there are different in the using language. The different is lie in the topic of conversation. The result of research about language and sex breaker in the 2 Meter Band radio communication gives the prove that between male and female has different topic of conversation. We can see that male has topic of conversation like politics, woman and togel while female has topic of conversation such as beauty, family and daily activity. While the cross conversation has topic of conversation like love, if the speakers is young. But if the speaker is old the topic of conversation is about family and general topic. In cross conversation is seen that male more rough in the using of language than female. So that female more polite than male when they are interaction. For example when male told *mboke malah mblending maneh*, the female gives response *serangan umum mbendina marahi*. It refer that language of female is more softer with male.

Besides the different of language and sex of breaker, in the 2 Meter Band radio communication, there are many norms of speaking to regulate of conversation because in the 2 Meter Band radio communication they can not face to face when they are interaction. The example norms of speaking in the 2 Meter

Band radio communication such as *kontek (contact)* is used when the breaker want to join in the frequency. *Contact* is usually use in the starting of conversation. *Pinjam (borrow)* is used when breaker want to call his friend in the frequency. The other *pinjam (borrow)* if the breaker want to call someone, he can used the word *intruk (interrupt)*. *Interrupt and borrow* is usually use in the keeping of conversation. *Cerio* 73 is used when breaker want to saying good bye. So norm of speaking in the 2 Meter Band radio communication is very important in order to the conversation is fluent.

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
